



ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

Purpose

It is the purpose of Happyland Day School to provide a quality, Christian education for the children of this community. We value the families of the school and work to maintain a strong relationship with all family members. Through creativity coupled with individualized and collaborative learning, Happyland provides a nurturing environment with programs that promote emotional and social development as well as problem-solving and critical thinking skills.

The school is governed by the Happyland Board of Directors and is responsible to the Session of the First Presbyterian Church of Fort Lauderdale. Corey Thiel is the Principal of Happyland Day School, and Steve Wofford is the Church Business Administrator.

Licensure

Happyland is licensed by the Florida Department of Children & Families and the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County and is an 8-time recipient of their Gold Seal Award. Our school boasts a tradition of over seventy years of excellence in early childhood education and child care.

Programs

Happyland encompasses programs for children ages 12 months through Kindergarten.

PLEASE NOTE: Children must have reached the appropriate age by September 1st of the year of enrollment. If you intend to enroll your child in a program where they do not meet the age requirements, approval must be obtained by the Principal of Happyland Day School.

Toddler Time: Our Toddler Time program provides a safe and nurturing environment to promote social, emotional, and physical development. Each day, age-appropriate activities are planned to encourage toddlers to learn and explore the world through music, movement, and hands-on learning. Students must be 12 months old by September 1. **Our toddler room is not equipped for napping, so students enrolled must have dropped their morning nap.**

PK-2: Our PK-2 program introduces students to the classroom experience by combining age-appropriate learning with social interaction and imaginative play. Weekly thematic units offer an introduction to letters, numbers, shapes, and basic math/language concepts. Purposeful play-based activities are incorporated to foster the development of fine and gross motor skills as well as creative thinking. Students must be two years of age by September 1.

PK-3: Our PK-3 program has a curriculum that is designed to encourage social and emotional development while learning the skills necessary to successfully move into Prekindergarten. Students move from academic to creative centers and participate in circle time to build self-esteem and promote a collaborative environment. The program will enhance existing language skills through phonemic awareness, teach math concepts such as patterning and sorting, and develop early writing and fine motor skills through the Handwriting without Tears program. Students must be three years of age by September 1. **Students entering our PK-3 program must be potty-trained.**

PK-4: Our PK-4 program provides a structured and creative environment for further development of math, reading, and language skills. The program incorporates a strong phonics foundation, an introduction to writing utilizing the Handwriting without Tears curriculum, and a hands-on math program using the Building Blocks curriculum which includes Smartboard technology. Happyland Day School participates in the State of Florida's VPK Program. Qualifying students can earn up to \$2,000 in annual tuition credit for meeting program requirements. KINDERGARTEN: Our Kindergarten curriculum encourages independent thinking while continuing to develop strong reading and math skills. Children continue to build strong phonics skills to ensure a solid foundation for reading success. Teaching methods are differentiated to meet the needs of all learners and include hands-on centers, teacher-led instruction, and self-directed learning. Students must be five years of age by September 1, 2019.

Extracurricular Programs: Science, Music, Spanish, and Physical Education are incorporated each week by teachers with special training in each subject area. These programs add excitement to the day and encourage the development of a well-balanced child.

Extended Day Program: Happyland offers an extension to the day in the morning and afternoon for an additional fee. We are open from 7:30 AM-5:30 PM.

MEDICAL RELEASE

I grant permission for my child to use all of the play equipment and participate in all activities of the center.
